

More Hip-Hop Drama Related to Rap Artist 50 Cent

The last few weeks have had hip-hop rap artist 50 Cent making news with his words or 'beefs' against what seems to be everyone.

The arrests came just days after Jamaica police announced they were investigating the hip-hop rappers crew in connection with an Oct. 15 shootout at a nearby restaurant.
