With all the financial problems that Hip Hop Mogul Marion 'Suge' Knight has seen over the last year, it seems that another lawsuit has been filed against the hip hop mogul.

Ex Death Row Records hip hop and R&B recording artist Nate Dogg, aka Nathaniel Hale, has, after 10 years, decided that he was "unsophisticated in record company business dealings", and has filed a lawsuit against Suge Knight for over 10 Million dollars; demanding back royalties that he says were never paid to him by the hip hop / rap mogul Marion 'Suge' Knight and or Death Row Records.
