Wash comments, "The purpose of the 'sisters in the Spirit" tour is to show the unity and strength of women today in gospel music." Gospel music veteran Kirk Franklin, a participant in the highly successful "Hopeville" tour, will offer his insight as a stage advisor and will not perform.

There is no one particular headliner for the tour. Instead, a sharing spirit of community will be the focus, as each artist will sing both solo and duets, backed by Sheila E's musical direction. While the uninitiated may wonder about the addition of Sheila E, Bynum offers insight to the choice, "Sheila E is the equivalent of Quincy Jones in terms of the breadth of musical knowledge she brings to the table."
