On October 15, 2005, there will be a gathering on the Mall in Washington, D.C. commemorating the 10th Anniversary of the Million Man March: "The Millions More Movement."

Endorsed by a wide diversity of groups and individuals such as the Congressional Black Caucus, the Worker's Movement, hip-hop and rap entrepreneur Russell Simmons, the New Black Panther Party and the National Council of Negro Women, organizing for the Millions More Movement has brought together over 100 leaders and organizers who have agreed to serve as co-conveners.

"For the first time in our history, those of us of different ideologies, philosophies, methodologies, denominations, sects and religions, political and fraternal affiliations have come together to create the Millions More Movement. It is the unity of our leadership and organizations. Our unity, the pooling of our resources, financially and intellectually will solve 95% of our problems,"stated the Convener, Min. Louis Farrakhan.
